Kerala State participated in the International Fair on Food, Food Processing & Related Equipments, Hotel & Restaurant Equipments & Supplies, 'AAHAR 2006', organised by India Trade Promotion Organisation (ITPO) at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi from 8th – 12th March, 2006.
