ORDER

The Director of Industries and Commerce as per letter read above, submitted a plan proposal for the Scheme 'Local Economic Development and Sustainability of Enterprises' and requested to accord administrative sanction for the Scheme of which the details are given below.

I. Objectives of the Scheme

i. As the Department of Industries and Commerce is transforming itself fully into online mode and is acting as a facilitator, facilities are to be provided to assist entrepreneurs in filing online applications for clearances under K-SWIFT, filing registration (Udyam Registration) for claiming MSME status and to avail various assistances. A trained manpower and facilitation centre has to be set up across the State to facilitate the entrepreneurs to use online services.

ii. The concept of MSME clinic is to set up a facility in each District Industries Centre wherein an entrepreneur or aspirant can walk in

physically or through online mode, interact with the experts (already empanelled) in each sector in a pre-assigned date and time and clear their queries/doubts.

iii. The scheme envisages to provide assistance by way of grant to students involved in developing and harnessing technological innovation to come up with solutions for problems besetting industrial activity as well as for encouraging innovation in the manufacturing sector.

iv).An expert, retired officer not below the rank of Joint Director of Directorate from the Industries Department is appointed to the Appraisal Desk who is assisting the State Grievance Redressal Committee to ensure its smooth functioning.

v. The scheme intends to conduct a one day General Orientation Training in all Local Self Government Institutions of the state to identify prospective entrepreneurs with the support of LSGI representatives. The identification of potential entrepreneurs will be done in a campaign mode. The second programme ie. License/Loan/Subsidy camps is to target the existing as well as new entrepreneurs.

2) The Departmental Working Group in its meeting held on 29.05.2024 approved the proposal and recommended to issue Administrative Sanction for the Scheme Local Economic Development and Sustainability of Enterprises-2024-25 for an amount of Rs 5,33,27,000 (Rupees Five Crore thirty three lakh and twenty seven thousand only) under the head of account 2851-00-102-98(P) from the plan fund limiting the expenditure to this year's budget provision with the condition that Pending bills of 14.82 Lakhs of previous Financial Year shall be met from current year's Budget provision.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs 548.09 Lakh (Rupees Five Crore Forty Eight Lakh and Nine Thousand only) to the Scheme 'Local Economic Development and Sustainability of Enterprises' under the Head of Account 2851-00-102-98 (P) from plan fund limiting the expenditure to the current year's budget provision subject to the condition that Pending bills of 14.82 Lakhs of previous Financial Year shall be met from current year's Budget provision.

projects/components of the Scheme are implemented in time and in the
manner as proposed in the letter read above.
